

Insurance Program/Risk Management

The district has the responsibility for maintaining an adequate insurance program covering its buildings and grounds, fleet of school vehicles and employees carrying out official duties for the district. The administration also may authorize and participate in insurance programs for employees and students.

The insurance program shall be administered by the chief financial officer, under the general supervision of the superintendent.

The administration shall make reasonable efforts to obtain insurance at the best available rates—consistent with required coverage and service—through obtaining quotations or bids.
