

Gifts/Donations to the School District

Any person or organization wishing to make a gift or donation to the schools of the district or to a particular school in the district shall submit to the superintendent a statement giving information relative to the nature of the gift or donation and its proposed use.

Gifts of money, equipment and materials may be accepted by the superintendent provided that such gifts incur no obligations to the district or district staff unless such obligations have been approved by the superintendent. Such gifts must be relevant to the district's educational program.

At the time of acceptance, there shall be a definite understanding with regard to the use of the gift, including whether it is intended for the use of one particular school or for all schools in the district.

When the gift or donation has been accepted, it shall become the property of the district.

The district reserves the right to accept or decline the proposed gift or donation.
